



Traineeship



for all Students and Graduates

Graduate – return **within 1 year** of graduation

For how long?

Up to 12 months of financing at one degree level of education (bachelor, master, doctoral)

Possibility of going abroad multiple times

Combination of study mobility + traineeship + BIP





Where can I go?


Stipend is set according to the living standards of a country and the length of stay

Group 1+2 | higher living costs |600€/month|

Group 3 | lower living costs |480€/month|

Selection procedure

Selection procedure takes place twice a year. Please contact the IRO office for current information.

- Required documents
 - 1. CV with contact details
 - 2. Motivation letter with a choice of university (1st to 3rd choice)
 - 3. Transcript of Records from UIS
 - 4. Language certificate (optional)





How to apply?



Selection procedure

Apply ideally 2 months before the start of the traineeship anytime during the year

- Required documents
 - 1. CV with contact details
 - 2. Motivation letter in English including: name of institution, country, preliminary term of traineeship and job description
 - 3. Language certificate (optional)

As a graduate you need to apply before graduation!

The EU institutions and other EU bodies are not accepted for the traineeship


